




Reward for Greenland halibut tags

The last few years the Institute of Marine Research (IMR) has tagged several thousand Greenland halibuts of all sizes. These experiments will help increase the knowledge on Greenland halibut behaviour, migrations, growth and age. However, to accomplish this, the IMR is completely dependent on reports and/or returns of recaptured tagged Greenland halibut from the fishing fleet.
