




Reward for Greenland halibut tags

The Institute of Marine Research (IMR) has tagged Greenland halibuts to be able to study the age by using otoliths and bone-structures. If you get a tagged Greenland halibut in your catch, we would like to have both the fish and the tag, together with the date and the position where the fish was caught.

The fishes have different tags and all the submitted tags will be rewarded with a T-shirt (remember to specify the correct size). If the fish is intact (not headless) we would like to examine all the fish and it is important to send us the fish with the tag still on.

Delivering/shipping of the fish is paid by IMR.
