Function tests of VAMS onboard are positive, pictures on monitors. Sampling with CTD/LADCP and Manta trawl on stations south of Mauritius.

The Chief Instrument Engineer Tore Mørk is re-terminating the broken CTD cable.

Due to bad weather and technical problems with broken CTD- cable we are behind scheduled survey plan.

## 6 Problems during field work

CTD- cable was ripped off, but no damage to the CTD sensors. The cable was re-terminated. Not possible to use CPR on the transect since it is calibrated for a speed of 10 knots. We cannot go more than 7-8 knots in the actual weather conditions.

We will continue on the transit to the Madagascar Ridge with sampling on the way according to sailing order.
